

PRIVATE LESSON PACKET

WELCOME

We're glad you're here! At Fuzion School of the Arts we believe that engaging in the arts builds confidence and character. Our team is committed to inspiring, encouraging, and challenging our students. When you join FSA you are joining a family.

This packet details information regarding our private lesson structure, pricing, policies and more!

PRICING

Private Lessons are \$100 a month. Full tuition is due regardless of the number of weeks in the month. Monthly tuition includes each weekly music lesson, dress rehearsal and performance.

PRACTICING

Your students teacher will assign music to practice each week to ensure musical growth! Encourage your child to practice! We ask families provide a notebook for weekly assignments to be written in. Your student's private lesson time with their teacher is the opportunity to learn new techniques and skills but it takes practicing at home to hone these skills!

CANCELATION & MAKE UPS

If you are unable to attend a private lesson, please give a minimum 24 hours notice in order to not be considered a 'last minute cancellation'. Last minute cancellations will not receive a makeup lesson. If you are able to give more than 24 hours notice, your students teacher will connect with you for a makeup lesson time. If a time cannot be worked out within a month of the missed lesson date, no refund will be given or credited to the following month. If an instructor is unable to make a lesson, they will contact you to reschedule ASAP.

LESSON STRUCTURE

Parents are not allowed to sit in on private lessons. This is to prevent distractions during the lesson and to create a bond between the teacher and student. The teacher will regularly send pictures and update on lessons afterwards! Drop off and Pick up for private lessons will be in Fuzion's main lobby!

LATE POLICY

Being on time is important for private lessons! If a student is over 10 minutes late to a lesson, the lesson will not take place that day, as a third of the time is gone. If a student is less that 10 minutes late, the student is able to still have their lesson however the teacher does reserve the right to end the lesson at the scheduled time.

ATTENDANCE

Attending lessons each week is a way to ensure your student is getting quality music instruction. Inconsistent attendance can resort to repeating the same material from the last lesson due to not being able to build upon the material from the following week. If attendance does become an issue, our team members do reserve the right to dismiss the lesson. If a student is consistently late and/or cancelling without notice, Fuzion reserves the right to discontinue lessons.

PERFORMANCE

At Fuzion School of the Arts we have two performances during the school year. We hold an observation night towards the end of the fall semester for parents to see the progress of their student. We hold our annual spring showcase in May, in which students are expected to participate. We assume all students are performing in our observation night and spring showcase unless our School Administrator has been notified otherwise.

Two of our core values are Excellence and Courage. We strive to show excellence in our performances, and we also want our students to walk in courage. We have seen such growth in our students who have been nervous to perform on stage! As an aspiring musician, students are encouraged to step out of their comfort zone, try something new, and show their families all they can accomplish!

WITHDRAW & SHOWCASE COMMITMENT

Families are able to withdraw at anytime during the school year. Please contact our office to withdraw from private lessons. If you do not withdraw by the day monthly tuition is due, you are still expected to pay for the remainder of the month.

Fuzion School of the Arts holds the expectation that all students will perform in our observation night as well as our annual spring showcase. Our annual spring showcase dates will release during our fall semester. Families are expected to communicate with the Scchool Administrator if they are not able to participate in our showcase no later than January 20th. If you inform us later than January 20th, you will still be expected to pay all showcase fees (May tuition, sheet music etc.)

Instructors and students spend a lo tof time, effort and energy in preparing for our annual spring showcase. When a student drops at the last minute this creates many challenges in our planning! We want to give our families a great showcase experience!

INSTRUMENTS AND BOOKS

If you do not already own the instrument you are wanting to take lessons with, our instructors are able to assist in the process of finding a quality instrument. If we do not have a donation for the instrument your student is wanting to take private lessons on, then we are unable to provide private lessons until they have an instrument of their own. After the first or second lesson, an instructor will recommend a book that will need to be ordered in a timely manner.

Private lessons are an incredible opportunity for students who are wanting to further their knowledge of music. Our private lesson program has fostered a passion in our students to share their instrument with their friends and family; and has even inspired students to pursue music as a career. Whether you are wanting to learn how to casually play the piano, become a professional clarinetist, or learn how to sing properly; we would love to have you take private lessons with us!
